THINGS TO REMEMBER ON PATROL

- * Remember when your patrols are, please be there on time, and if you can't make it, organise a substitute and inform your Patrol Captain.
- * The tent must be erected on patrol and ALL patrolling members are to wear patrol uniforms, a patrol cap and hat, and plenty of sunscreen.
- * Make sure all equipment is cleaned and locked up at the end of the day.
- * Also make sure that the SSV and radios are on charge.
- * Each patrol MUST have fill all LSA obligations
- * Each patrol MUST have an IRB Driver, IRB Crew, SMBM and ART
- * If there is any equipment that is broken and needs to be repaired please inform your Patrol Captain

WHAT TO DO IF YOU CANNOT MAKE A PATROL?

- * Post on the Patrol Swap/Availability Facebook page the date and times you need a sub as well as the qualifications that are needed.
- * If you don't have Facebook - email and/or text message the members with the appropriate qualifications asking if they can substitute
- * Inform your Patrol Captain no later than the Tues before your patrol
- * Inform the Director of Lifesaving via email or text message if you have not been able to find a substitute

So that it doesn't burden your fellow members we ask that you exhaust all avenues to find a substitute before advising the Director of Lifesaving**

Minimum requirements for patrols

- Approved and inspected equipment as outlined in the Standard Operating Procedures
- Volunteer Bronze Medallion qualified patrol members with numbers as outlined above, including;
 - 1 x proficient ARTC award holder
 - 1 x proficient IRB Driver
 - 1 x Silver Medallion Beach Management award holder
 - 1 x proficient IRB Crew

Exemptions

1. From the start of the season until Sunday 24th November and from Saturday 7th March until the end of the season, the Club may request a 3pm finish. The request may be made in consultation with the NB Council Lifeguard and the SNB Duty Officer or RCO. Approval must be agreed upon by the SNB Director of Lifesaving or his authorised delegate and the Lifeguard Supervisor no later than 2pm on the day.
The following conditions can include:
 - Adverse weather conditions such as heavy rain, thunder storms, strong winds.
 - If beach attendance in primary patrolling area is below 20 persons at 2pm.
2. In the event of erosion causing unsafe IRB access to the beach, the Club will be given an IRB exemption from the SNB Director of Lifesaving.
