PROVISIONS:

General

1. Selection for carnivals will be under advisement from the Director of Competition and the Director of Junior Activities (for Nippers only)
2. A Team Manager will be appointed by the Committee. The Team Managers role includes organising travel, accommodation, entries, supervising team conduct and general tour coordination.
3. Chaperone/s will be appointed by the Committee if the touring team has members under the age of 18 years. The chaperone is to ensure these members are well looked after and are conducting themselves in an appropriate manner. The chaperones will reflect the genders represented by the team.
4. All members behaviour is to reflect the SLSA Code of Conduct.
5. The member must be have completed their membership form via SurfGuard and paid their subscriptions before being entered for any Carnival.
6. The member must be proficient in the award relevant to compete and completed their patrol obligations.
7. If the member is a competitor they must complete the minimum patrol requirements for active membership irrelevant of their membership status. This applies to all membership categories including Active, Active Reserve and Long Service members.
8. Late entries to any Branch, State or National event must be referred to the Club Committee with explanation due to the additional levy imposed for these events.
9. The appropriate attire must be worn when representing South Narrabeen SLSC at Carnivals. The Clubs existing colours and badges shall not be altered without endorsement of the Club and re-endorsement of SLS NSW and the approval of SLSA.
 - Hi-vis singlet (with Club sponsor if applicable) and in good condition

- Competition cap (cotton or lycra) identifiable and in good condition
- Swimwear or clothing identifiable, in good condition and appropriate for event contesting

10. The member must wear attire distinguishing themselves as a competitor for South Narrabeen SLSC. Competitors are not to wear other Clubs apparel whilst representing the Club. The Club colours are royal blue and orange. The orange may vary depending on material used for competition cap and attire
